

#### RELIEF REVIVAL: WORKING REDUCTIVELY

This workshop will focus on how to work reductively with the process of relief printmaking. Students will learn techniques to push the limitations of a single block to achieve a full range of colors and tones. Different methods of transferring images onto the block, registration, cutting tips, tool sharpening, ink mixing, and the use of stencils and other alternative methods will be taught.
